Further to my comments at Wilder and Valentia Mark Master Mason Lodges I have hired from Hobbs of Henley their flagship vessel the "New Orleans" river boat. (Like a paddle steamer with two long black funnels to facilitate going under bridges).

The absolute limit is 84 people.

Sunday 27th May 2018 is the day 14:00hrs to 17:00hrs from embarking to disembarking. Earliest boarding will commence at 13.45hrs.

This is a beautiful boat, the very lively and professional jazz band is the real biz and a buffet is also included.

The price is £35.00 per person.

There is a bar on board. Parking is in the Henley railway station car park - a short walk away.

My previous trip on the "New Orleans" was exceptionally enjoyable. We included a couple of locks, enjoyed our lovely river Thames and fine views. The band is exceptionally good.

In the event of bad weather we and the band would move to the lower deck.
